Balcony Tiling Layout (Inspection and Test Procedure)

Objective: This procedure aims to ensure the proper layout and alignment of balcony tiles, providing an aesthetically pleasing and structurally sound tiling installation.

Materials and Tools:

- Tape Measure
- Spirit Level
- Chalk Line or Laser Level
- Square
- Tile Spacers

Inspection and Test Points:

 - Inspect the overall appearance of the balcony tiling layout for any imperfections or irregularities.
